Then simply mail original prescriptions and a copy of your prescription card to: CampRx, 1179 Maplelawn Dr., Troy, MI 48084. *Prescriptions must be received 30 days in advance.*

FACTS & QUESTIONS

Why is Our Camp Requiring Us to Use CampRx?

Most camps select CampRx for two reasons: safety and ease of use. Prepackaged medication all but eliminates the risk of missed or incorrect dosing, and our service saves camps many hours of staff time gathering and organizing campers' medications.

Is Your Company Experienced?

CampRx is a subsidiary of DirectRx, an independent specialty pharmacy with more than 20 years of experience serving nationwide customers via mail-order.

How Much Does CampRx Cost?

We charge a modest fee of between \$15 and \$40 depending upon how long your child's stay is at camp. Our fee does not include the cost of your child's medications.

Will Our Insurance Pay for the Medications?

Almost always. Our pharmacy accepts a wide variety of insurance plans, and most companies provide a "vacation override" even if you are not due for a refill. A handful of insurers will not provide reimbursement for pharmacies that are outside of their network. However, we will notify you prior to sending your child's medication to camp if this is the case.

How do I order from CampRx?

Register online at www.camprx.com, or print our Mail-Order Packet. Then simply mail original prescriptions and a copy of your prescription card to: CampRx, 1179 Maplelawn Dr., Troy, MI 48084. Prescriptions must be received 30 days in advance.

IT'S ALL IN THE PACKAGE

Dose strip packaging makes our safer process possible. Campers' medications are dispensed, sealed, and labeled for daily dosing right at the pharmacy. An easy-open package makes administration at camp simple and foolproof.

Our packaging is also waterproof and tearproof, making it ideal for use on trips away from camp.

How can I pay for CampRx?

Payment is not due until your order is complete. After we have received your camper's prescriptions by mail, we will begin processing your camper's order. When the order is complete, we will determine your pharmacy charge (typically representing any applicable insurance co-pays and the cost of over-the-counter medications) and add that to your CampRx fee. We will bill your credit card and send you an E-invoice representing the charge we made to your credit card.

How are the medications packaged?

Each dose of medication is sealed in a medication strip package with a detailed label that includes your child's name, date of birth, medications enclosed, date and time to be administered, and any special instructions. The camp staff simply tears open the perforated packet and hands your child his medications. Please note that only medications in pill form can be included in the dose strip. Other medications, such as inhalers, creams, and liquids, are dispensed and labeled separately and shipped to camp with your child's other medications.

How will the charges appear on my credit card statement? You will see a charge from GabeCare DirectRx for your CampRx fee, plus over the counter/ prescription medication co-pays and costs from the DirectRx pharmacy.

Can you package half of a pill?

Yes, if your child's prescription is written that way.

Will your pharmacy dispense brand-name products or generic products?

Unless the physician specifies "Do Not Substitute" or "Brand Only" our pharmacy will dispense the generic. Many insurance plans will only pay for a generic. If you do not want a generic, we ask that you notify your physician in advance. For OTC medications, our pharmacy will provide generics unless you specify otherwise.
